RESOLUTION 12-10**

**A RESOLUTION RECONFIRMING SUPPORT FOR THE ALASKA COASTAL MANAGEMENT
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Sea Party has gathered enough signatures to place the restoration of the Alaska Coastal Management Program (ACMP) on the August 28, 2012 ballot as a voter initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Coastal Management Program as proposed will provide for project and permit coordinating between developers, federal, state and local jurisdictions over development projects within the coastal zone; and,

WHEREAS, the Lake and Peninsula Borough participated in ACMP as a coastal district with an approved coastal management plan from incorporation through June 30, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, the Lake and Peninsula Borough supports local control over decisions made within the borough and prioritizes local input on developments within the borough; and

WHEREAS, involvement in ACMP enables the borough to participate in the permitting process for projects on federal, state, and local lands within the borough's coastal zone; and,

WHEREAS, ACMP results in the maximum amount of local input and control in accordance with Lake and Peninsula Borough policy; and,


WHEREAS, an approved coastal management plan for the borough will allow it to set locally decided enforceable policies for development projects.
